Q: Is accommodation provided for internship at Barwon Health?

Interns who are rotated out to a rural rotation (i.e. Warrnambool or Hamilton) will have accommodation provided.

For rotations based at Barwon Health sites, such as University Hospital Geelong or the McKellar Centre, interns must organise their own accommodation.
